- 1. In December, 2007, the Chief Justice of the Navajo Nation requested the assistance of the Judicial Conference in the revision of the Standard Operating Procedures of Probation and Parole Services, which was last revised in 1992.
- 2. Drafts were distributed for comment in December, 2007, and in June and August, 2008. Comments were received and revisions made on each draft during lengthy comment periods through November 21, 2008.
- 3. It is in the best interest of the Judicial Branch courts and programs, and the Navajo people, that the revised Standard Operating Procedures, dated November 19, 2008 be put in immediate use.

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

We, the judges and justices of the Courts of the Navajo Nation, hereby recommend that the attached <u>Exhibit "A"</u> Standard Operating Procedures, dated November 19, 2008, be put in immediate use.
