## PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT FROM WINDOW ROCK JUDICIAL DISTRICT

The Window Rock Judicial District is operating and performing essential services temporarily from the former Supreme Court hearing room at the Butler building in Window Rock, Ariz. Exterior doors to all Navajo Nation Judicial Branch courts and programs are locked for the safety of employees and the public. No in-person services are being provided by the Window Rock Judicial District at this time.

Telephone messages for the court may be left at (928) 206-7469. Messages will be checked periodically throughout the work day and returned by Window Rock court staff. Faxes to the Window Rock District Court may be sent to (928) 725-3786 until further notice. The drop box outside the Window Rock District Court is temporarily unavailable.

The public may also communicate with the Window Rock District Court through mail. The mailing address is P.O. Box 5520, Window Rock, AZ 86515.

All scheduled hearings will continue to be held by teleconference. If you have any questions, please contact the court.

Payments for fines and fees may be paid by money order to "Navajo Nation" and mailed to Window Rock Judicial District, P.O. Box 5520, Window Rock, AZ 86515. Please include docket number and contact information.

The Administrative Office of the Courts facility, where the Window Rock District Court has been temporarily stationed since July 2018, is temporarily closed; however, services are still being provided. The Judicial Branch Human Resources office within the Administrative Office will only accept job applications through email, fax or U.S. mail during the public health emergency.
