

Constellation

The Quartz People/ Tsé Ghádi'nídínii assisted the group in setting a pattern of Stars to determine the age, era, and time for the people. This time, Coyote was not the first who suggested this plan for the constellations. The Quartz People planed and set up a pattern for the constellations to tell time, age and era. This plan took twelve times again. All winter patterns of stars were set aside and separated from summer patterns. Special stars were assigned to lead the rest of the stars in their sections within the universe. One special star was Big Star for the winter pattern. The leading star must have five points, just as the Hogan has a five pointed frame and the human being has five fingers. Atse'átsoh star, was the other star for the summer pattern of stars. They must have a cane, so a cane pattern was formed. Next was the Dawn pattern and the Milky Way pattern were created.

Blue Corn cooked in ashes was prepared after the grinding stones was ready to be placed, but it was forgotten until last. Coyote knew this and grabbed it and ran with it. The stars were patterned and given names: Dilyéhé, Atsé'ats'ózi, Hastiin Sik'ai'i, Sọ' Łání, Atse'atsoh, Sọ' Ahóts'i'i, and Gahaat'e'ii were all placed as planned. The group wondered what it should do with the stars that were left. Just then, the Coyoted entered and grabbed one reddish star and flung it to the north which landed the furthest away and proclaimed that that one will be his star and as it is known to this day as Ma'ii Bizọ'; as he also referred to himself as Yikáih Be'ewéé' and Yikáih Tah Dilwoshí Next, he grabbed the blanket of stars and them up in the sky and named them "many stars". "What else can one do? Was the Coyote's question as he threw the blanket of stars in the sky. All these events took place at the rim of the emergence.
